15. To receive an update from the Community Development Officer.

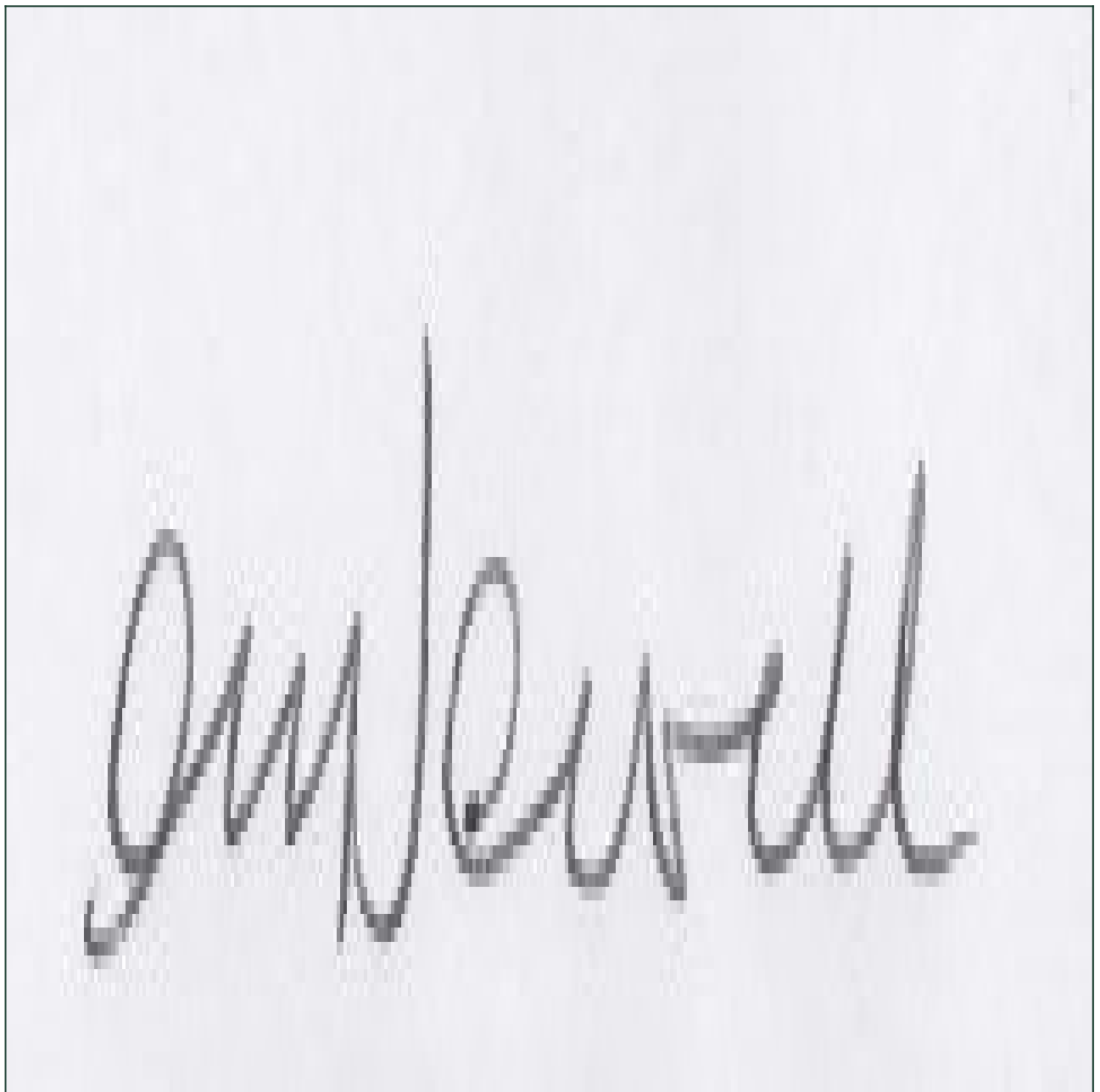
